

Resolution No. BFPD 2026-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BURNEY
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SPECIAL
PARCEL TAX LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 PURSUANT TO
ORDINANCE NO. BFPD 2024-01**

WHEREAS, the voters of the Burney Fire Protection District (“District”) approved a special parcel tax known as Measure F at the election held on November 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. BFPD 2024-01 authorizes the levy of a special parcel tax on nonexempt parcels within the District to fund rescue, emergency medical care and ambulance, hazardous material emergency response, and fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. BFPD 2024-01 requires the Board of Directors to establish the amount of the special parcel tax levy annually by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed the schedule of parcel use categories and corresponding parcel tax amounts as set forth in Section 2 of Ordinance No. BFPD 2024-01;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Burney Fire Protection District as follows:

1. The Board hereby establishes the special parcel tax levy for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 as shown below, in accordance with Ordinance No. BFPD 2024-01:

Parcel Use Category	Annual Charge
Vacant/Unimproved	\$30
Single-Family Residential	\$75
Rural Residential/Improved	\$192
Multi-Family Residential (2–4 units)	\$309
Multi-Family Residential (5–9 units)	\$388
Multi-Family Residential (10+ units)	\$465
Commercial	\$546
Industrial	\$910
Retail (10,000+ sq ft)	\$910
Mobile Home Site	\$90

2. The Board directs District staff to transmit the approved parcel tax levy to the Shasta County Tax Collector for placement on the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 property tax roll.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
