All charges or complaints against employees shall be submitted to the Board of Fire Commissioners under provisions contained in the Burney Fire Protection District Administrative Instruction.

If the Chairperson finds that there is, in fact, willful disruption of any meeting of the Board, he/she may order the room cleared and subsequently conduct the Board's business without the audience present except for duly accredited representatives of the news media, whom the Chairperson finds not to have participated in the disruption.
